Hi, my name is Cory Carlotto, and I am 30 years old.

I live in Pittsfield, Massachusetts and grew up in Dalton, Massachusetts.

I am a SDM Member of the Nonotuck and Center Public Representation Pilot Program from Massachusetts.

I have developmental delays, and I am on the autism spectrum. I live in independent living. I require help learning how to handle my apartment and to understand my choices when I have a decision to make.

My parents placed me under guardianship at age 18 until I matured. Nothing else was available.

On November 17, 2015, I was the first person in the Massachusetts courts to have their guardianship replaced by Supported Decision Making. My supporters help me understand my choices in life, but I make my **own** decisions. This is **MY** life.
